With the cost of living soaring, and inflation continuing to rise at a higher rate than that of local government pay: council staff are finding it harder to make ends meet. As a living wage employer, Council supports leisure workers in their campaign for an above inflation pay rise. Council is also concerned that the outsourcing of vital amenities such as leisure centres constitutes a less efficient way to run these services. Council, therefore, commits to begin and complete all necessary work to insource leisure services back under the control of Belfast City Council, without third party management of staff and services." Proposer: Councillor Michael Collins Seconder: Councillor Anthony Flynn 3.3 The motion calls upon the Council to commit to begin and complete all necessary work to insource leisure services back under the control of Belfast City Council, without third party management of staff and services.
