Main Report 3.0 3.1 The City Growth and Regeneration Committee at its meeting on 4 June 2025 considered a report updating Members following the appointment of GRAHAM as Council's Private Sector Partner. This included the requirement for Council to interface effectively with GRAHAM through the project governance arrangements and utilising existing Council structures. It was highlighted to the Committee that in endorsing the procurement of a PSP there was a strong 3.2 emphasis from Elected Members on the need for engagement with them throughout delivery of this housing led regeneration programme and they requested that consideration be given to the best mechanism for such engagement.
