3.1	Article 8 of the Planning (General Development Procedure) Order (Northern Ireland) 2015 sets out how the Council must publicise planning applications.					2015
3.2	In addition to the requirements to notify neighbours and publish notice of the application on the NI Planning Portal website, Article 8(1)(a) requires the Council to 'publish notice of the application in at least one newspaper circulating in the locality in which the land to which the application relates is situated.'					

	Confirmation of new contract for publishing planning notices				
3.3	The contract for publishing planning notices in the newspaper was previously fulfilled by the Belfast Telegraph. The contract has come to an end and a new contract has been awarded following a competitive tender exercise. The new contract has been awarded to Mediahius UK (Belfast Telegraph). The contract is for three years and runs to September 2026, with the option to extend for two further years.
