3.1	The following motion on the Robinson Centre, which will be proposed by Councillor O’Hara and seconded by Councillor Nic Biorna, is due to be presented to the Council at its meeting on 7th January.

	<p>“This Council opposes the naming of the new Council leisure facility on the land at Montgomery Road as “The Robinson Centre” and agrees that this facility be renamed in accordance with Council policy.</p> <p>The naming of any Council facility must be inclusive and welcoming to all. The previous centre on this land was named “The Robinson Centre” and was within the Castlereagh Borough Council area before the changes in council boundaries when councils reduced in number from twenty-six to eleven. This is a new facility and must come under existing Council policy.</p> <p>Belfast City Council’s policy is clear.
