3.1	Under section 49A of the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 ('the Act'), (as amended by the Disability Discrimination(NI) Order 2006) public authorities, when carrying out their functions must have due regard to the need to:				
	<ul> <li>Promote positive attitudes towards disabled people; and</li> <li>Encourage participation by disabled people in public life.</li> </ul>				
3.2	The Council's current Disability Action Plan expired in March 2022. In January, we carried out a disability exercise with the departments and by doing this, we were able to develop the three-year DDO Disability Action Plan.				
3.3	The three-year DDO Disability Action Plan items are now being presented as a draft document to proceed through the Committee cycle and to go out for public consultation as required.				
3.4	This draft document is presented to the Strategic Policy and Resources Committee for approval and will be submitted for a twelve-week period of public consultation from 30th May – 19th August 2022. The final document will then be resubmitted to Council with any subsequent amendments.
