C&amp;NS invited a representative of the Disability Motoring UK's Disabled Parking Accreditation scheme to visit our sites. They made a number of recommendations including ensuring we have at least one blue badge bay in each of our car parks. All our parking bays already meet this criterion, as do the Pay and Display machines.</p> <p>C&amp;NS will consider reconfiguring and relocating some Blue Badge bays to make them even more accessible as well as improving some of the access routes via additional dropped kerbs and other minor works. They are mapping out the requirements for each car park, to cost the necessary work to add to additional membership charges.</p>

While it may have been reported a few months ago that a reduction in student numbers was one possible recourse among many to mitigate potential Departmental budget reductions, it transpires that the Department has been able to maintain its higher education budget. While DfE do not believe that a presentation is required, QUB have responded to confirm that they are happy to present at a future meeting.
