### **Belfast Cycle Network Delivery Plan**

At its meeting in September, Belfast City Council's City Growth and Regeneration Committee agreed that the Council would write to you to request an update on the proposed timeline for the roll-out the Belfast Cycle Network according to the delivery plan that was announced in March 2022. Due to safety concerns within the area, the Committee also requested that DfI install an additional piece of infrastructure, in the form of a pedestrian crossing at the Ravenhill Road/Ardenlee Avenue Junction, either as a part of the Belfast Cycle Network or depending on timeframes, in advance of the wider scheme.
