BELFAST CYCLE DELIVERY PLAN AND PEDESTRIAN CROSSING AT ARDENLEE AVENUE ON RAVENHILL ROAD

Thank you for your email of 19 October 2022, regarding the delivery plan for the Belfast Cycling Network and request for a controlled pedestrian crossing at Ardenlee Avenue on the Ravenhill Road.

The Belfast Cycle Network Delivery Plan (BCNDP) contains a large number of schemes that are intended to encourage cycling in the city and reduce the dependency on the use of the private car.

Officials are currently developing a number of schemes within the BCNDP for inclusion in a short term plan for delivery between 2022 and 2025.

With regard to your request for a controlled crossing on the Ravenhill Road at Ardenlee Avenue. In order to fully consider your request it will be necessary for local officials to carry out a survey after which they will write to you directly to advise of the outcome.
