3.2	The Committee, at its Special meeting in February, received a presentation from the Strategic
	Planning and Performance Group of the Department of Health in relation to GP Services in
	Belfast. During discussion, concerns were raised regarding the disparity in Northern Ireland,
	where GPs were the only GPs in the UK who paid their own indemnity costs, which increased
	the more hours in which they worked. The Committee agreed that it would write to the
	Permanent Secretary to request an update on the work being undertaken to resolve GP
	indemnity in Northern Ireland, together with the following questions which had been added by
	the Council at its meeting on 1st March:
	<ul> <li>What mitigation measures were being taken to try and address the number of GPs leaving the Health Services?; and</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>What measures were being taken to try and increase the number of medical students year on year?</li> </ul>
