1.0 Purpose of report or summary of main issues

1.1 The purpose of this report is to ask Members to consider and approve the Council's Annual Report to the Equality Commission (ECNI) for 2023/24. The scope of the report covers our statutory duties relating to equality and disability. 2.0 Recommendations 2.1 The Committee is asked to approve the Council's Annual Report to ECNI for 2023/24. 3.0 Main report **Key Issues** 3.1 Members will be aware of the Council's statutory duties relating to equality and disability: The Section 75 statutory duties require designated public authorities to have due regard to the need to promote equality of opportunity in relation to the nine equality categories and to have regard to the desirability of promoting good relations. A public authority's equality scheme sets out how it will comply with both duties. The Disability Discrimination Act 1995 ("DDA") Section 49A requires designated public authorities to have due regard to the need to promote positive attitudes towards disabled persons, and to the need to encourage participation by disabled persons in public life. This duty is supported by an obligation to have a disability action plan. 3.2 ECNI provide a template for annual reporting with Part A providing information on Section 75 and Part B outlining our actions on the Disability Discrimination Act 1995 ("DDA") Section 49A (see Appendix 1). 3.3 In preparation of the Annual Report to ECNI all Departments provide an update on actions they are delivering in both equality and diversity (Appendix 2). Our Equality Action Plan commenced in 2021 and expires in 2024. It contains some of the key priorities from our Corporate Plan, which will have the biggest impact on inequalities. It also promotes compliance with Section 75. 3.4 Our Disability Action Plan is a detailed vision on how we plan to promote positive attitudes towards disabled people and encourage their participation in public life in relation to our functions from April 2022 to March 2025. These duties reaffirm our commitment to the Disability Discrimination Act 1995.
