### Belfast Off - Street Parking (Public Car Parks) Order 2026

Notice is hereby given that the Belfast City Council in the exercise of the powers conferred through (a) Articles 10, 13, 14(3) and 26(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 (b) and Off-street Parking (Functions of District Councils) Act (Northern Ireland) 2015 proposes to make an Order entitled The Belfast Off - Street Parking (Public Car Parks) Order 2026.

The Off-Street Parking (Belfast) Order 2026 will:

- Reproduce provisions of previous orders
- Introduce concession for Blue Badge parking (Article 19)
- Include 4 existing public car parks (Schedule 1)
- Introduce provision for the suspension of car parking places for works or events to be undertaken (Article 32)

The Order will affect the following Off-Street Car Parks:

- Parkgate Avenue
- Shaw's Bridge
- Slieve Gallion
- Stranmillis
