1	Relevant Background Information
1.1	The Northern Ireland Local Government Association (NILGA), in partnership with Climate Northern Ireland, are organising a morning seminar to discuss recent weather related events and address how Northern Ireland Councils can prepare and respond to similar events should they occur in the future.
