## Relevant Background Information The Committee will be aware that the Council is the lead partner in the ERDF funded INTERREG IVC Project B-Team, which seeks to bring together specialists in Brownfields regeneration from different countries. This Team aims to improve developments and enhance regional policies focusing on the resolution of practical challenges on case study sites in the partner countries. The Partners cities include Dublin (Ireland), Sevilla (Spain), Oulu (Finland), Dresden (Germany), Ruda Slaska (Poland), Hajdu-Bihar (Hungary), Torino (Italy) and Vilnius (Lithuania).
