1.1	The Association of Municipal Authorities of Ireland (AMAI) is holding its Spring Seminar in New Ross, County Wexford from Friday, 15th to Saturday, 16th February.
1.2	The theme of the Seminar is 'Putting People First – Local Government Reform Real or Imaginary?' Keynote speakers will include Des Dowling, Assistant Secretary in the Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government, Brian Cotter, Public Affairs and Business Development Director at the American Chamber of Commerce in Ireland and Councillor Joe Anderson, O.B.E., the first Directly Elected Mayor of Liverpool.
