1	Relevant Background Information
1.1	Members will be aware that, under the revised Scheme of Delegation, approval must be sought from the relevant Committee prior to inviting tenders for the supply of goods or services.
1.2	To assist in the delivery of the 2013/14 Planned Maintenance Programme and an agreed programme of non-recurring capital works it will be necessary to invite tenders for a number of specific single projects as listed in Appendix A. The combined estimated total value of these contracts is £508,000.
1.3	Detailed specifications are to be prepared in order to permit the contracts to be let, and subject to Committee approval advertisements will be placed in the local press inviting applications for Invitation to Tender.

2	Key Issues
2.1	The planned maintenance programme and non-recurring capital works have been agreed and work has already commenced on a wide range of projects. To assist in the delivery of these works a number of tenders for specialist contractors are now required. Further detail on cost & duration is detailed in Appendix A.
2.2	Submissions will be evaluated in accordance with agreed evaluation criteria and in liaison with the Procurement Section where appropriate.
