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# (i) Benview and Ballysillan Play Centre – Licence Renewal Community Services have used part of Benview Community Centre to run a Belfast City Council play centre since June 1997. The portion of the building used is held under Licence Agreement from Benview and Ballysillan Avenue Tenants Association. At its meeting on 15 January 2013 the Development Committee approved the renewal of the existing Licence Agreement for a further 18 months from 1 July 2012, subject to the Strategic Policy and Resources Committee approval in accordance with Standing Order 46. (ii) An Munia Tober, Glen Road – Lease Renewal An Munia Tober is the main Traveller support group within Northern Ireland and provide specific services to Travellers within the greater Belfast area and also provide a regional support role. AMT have been leasing from the Council two

## (i) Benview and Ballysillan Play Centre – Licence Renewal A further term of 18 months from the 1 July 2012 has been recommended by Community Services at the existing rent of £4025.56 per annum. (ii) An Munia Tober, Glen Road – Lease Renewal The Lease dated 3 March 2008 provides for an extension of up to 5 years subject to Council approval. Approval is sought to extend the lease for 5 years from the 1 October 2012 at the current rent of £1,000 per annum.

3	Resource Implications
3.1	(i) Benview and Ballysillan Play Centre – Licence Renewal Financial The Council will be liable to pay a total licence fee of £6,038.35 for the 18 months term to the Tenants Association for partial use of the Centre. This fee also covers all utility charges, with the Council undertaking some weekly routine cleaning in the Centre.
3.2	Human Resources Staff resource, primarily from Estates Unit and Legal Services will be required to complete the Licence Agreement renewal.
3.3	Asset and Other Implications None
3.4	(ii) An Munia Tober, Glen Road – Lease Renewal Financial An Munia Tober receive an annual revenue grant from the Council.
3.5	Human Resources Staff resource, primarily from Estates Unit and Legal Services will be required to complete the Licence Agreement renewal.

5.2	(ii) An Munia Tober, Glen Road – Lease Renewal It is recommended that Committee agree to a further lease to AMT for 5 years at £1,000 per annum.
