1	Relevant Background Information
1.1	The Council has received notification of the Association of Municipal Authorities of Ireland (AMAI) Spring Seminar in Bundoran, County Donegal which is taking place from Friday, 14th to Saturday, 15th February, 2014.
1.2	The main theme of the Seminar is "The Local Government Landscape from June 2014 Onwards". The Seminar will, amongst other things, examine the mechanisms which Local Government can put in place to maximise service delivery for citizens. There will also be sessions on learning from the past and focusing on the future and how the utilisation of social and printed media can assist Elected Representatives. Keynote speakers at the Seminar will include Dr. Seán O'Riordáin, Director of the Public Policy Advisers Network and Feargal Brophy, founder and Executive Director of Open Financial Services.
1.3	The Council has been represented at AMAI events for a number of years and participants at previous events have felt that their attendance provided them with a valuable opportunity to meet with Local Government Representatives from throughout Ireland to discuss issues of mutual interest and concern.
