I have been using the Belfast Bikes for around 5 months on a regular basis, picking up a bike close to where my lift drops me off and leaving it at the docking station right outside my office. It would normally take me around 20 minutes to walk this distance, but I can complete my journey in around 7 minutes on a Belfast Bike.

Since the scheme started, I have seen a couple of vandalised bikes but, on the whole, the bikes are well maintained. If you report something wrong with a bike, it is repaired very quickly. I downloaded the app to my smart-phone and find it to be very efficient, as I can check before I leave the house / office if there are bikes available at my starting point and spaces to dock at my destination.



Best of all, as none of my journeys have exceeded 30 minutes, every journey has been free, so my total outlay to date has been £20 for a year's membership of the scheme!


