3.1	<u>Key Issues</u> The independent evaluation, “ <i>A New Story: Titanic Belfast – Evaluation of the first three years</i> ” was commissioned by the Titanic Foundation and was carried out by Deloitte.
3.2	Titanic Foundation is the charity which was set up in 2008 to oversee the development of Titanic Belfast. Titanic Belfast, a £76 million visitor attraction, was one of five national tourism priorities for Tourism Northern Ireland and the Department of Enterprise Trade and Investment (DETI). It was one of the first key investment decisions of the NI Executive and was supported by Belfast City

	Council, Belfast Harbour Commission and Titanic Quarter Limited.
