Work is underway to coordinate ongoing dialogue but in the meantime TransportNI continues to liaise with Council in relation to specific proposals.

	Proposals:			
3.1	Falls Road (between Beechmount Avenue & Thames Street) - Waiting Restrictions to facilitate Belfast Rapid Transit (BRT) TransportNI proposes to introduce waiting restrictions on the Falls Road in order to			
	facilitate the operation of the new BRT buses by regulating all day parking to aid traffic progression on approach to bus lanes.			
3.2	It is proposed to introduce additional waiting restrictions (i.e. double yellow lines) 'at any time' at the following locations along Falls Road: • 28m of waiting restriction between Beechmount Avenue and Islandbawn Drive; • 14m of waiting restriction between Shiels Street and Broadway;			
	 23.5m of waiting restriction between Broadway and Thames Street; and 9.5m of waiting restriction between Nansen Street and Broadway. 			
3.3	Members should note that the Council has previously supported the work to progress the development of the BRT scheme. It is therefore recommended that the Council should support the introduction of the proposed waiting restrictions outlined above.			
3.4	Rosetta Primary School - Mandatory 'School Keep Clear' Restriction TransportNI proposes to make the 'School Keep Clear' restriction at the entrance to Rosetta Primary School mandatory. The existing markings are only advisory and are therefore not currently legally enforceable. The aim of such markings is to keep the area clear of parked vehicles thus making pedestrians and children crossing the road more visible. The proposed mandatory restriction will prohibit waiting from 1 September to 30			
3.5	June, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 8:00am - 9:15am and 2:30pm – 4:30pm. Glenbryn Park and Glenbryn Drive - Proposed Traffic Calming Measures

3.10	Finally, Members are asked to note that, further to previous correspondence, in relation to the proposed abandonment at Thornburn Road TransportNI has provided a copy of the Draft Order, a location map and the Statutory Notice of Intention. This is for information purposes only and no further comment is required at this stage. TransportNI will forward a copy of the Order to the Council when it comes into operation.			
3.9	Glenmachan Place - Proposed Additional Waiting Restrictions TransportNI is considering the introduction of additional "At any time" waiting restrictions at Glenmachan Place.			
3.8	Sydenham Road Access Road - Proposed New Waiting Restrictions Following concerns raised by the Belfast Harbour Police regarding traffic progression and safety concerns on the Sydenham Road access road as a result of all day parking on the north west side, it is proposed to introduce 197m of 'At any time' waiting restriction.			
3.7	Rugby Avenue - Proposed One-way Traffic System A number of one way streets and corner restrictions have been in place in the Holylands area for over a year and are considered to have improved the overall traffic management in the area. TransportNI proposes to introduce a one-way traffic system in Rugby Avenue between the Ormeau Road and Carmel Street to address traffic progression difficulties in the street. A letter drop has already taken place with residents in November and no adverse comments were received.
