

### **Abandonment – Fortwilliam Parade, Belfast**

The Department for Regional Development, being of the opinion that another road is available which provides alternative facilities for road traffic, proposes to make an Order to abandon 306.2 square metres of alleyway to the rear of Nos. 24-54 and to side of No. 54 Fortwilliam Parade, Belfast.

The area of road proposed to be abandoned is delineated on a map which, together with a copy of a draft order, may be inspected free of charge during office hours within the period from 4th May 2016 to 13th June 2016 at the Department's Headquarters, Clarence Court, 10-18 Adelaide Street, Belfast and at TransportNI Eastern Division, Hydebank, 4 Hospital Road, Belfast or viewed online at [www.drdni.gov.uk/consultations](http://www.drdni.gov.uk/consultations)
