
TAKE NOTICE that the Department for Communities, in accordance with the provisions of Article 103 of the Planning (Northern Ireland) Order 1991, ("the 1991 Order"), proposes to make an order under Article 102 of that order to extinguish the public right of way over the Pedestrian Pathway at Ravenhill Reach Mews to Ravenhill Reach containing 276 square metres and shown outlined in red on the attached map.

The Department for Communities considers that the extinguishment is necessary for the proper development of the land over which the public right of way exist.
