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Description of areas to be extinguished for the Upper New Lodge Ext. Order

The entire length of Hillman Street (adjacent to Lepper Street) from houses numbered 133/169, and from 126/148 Hillman Street on the other side, to include both footpaths and roadway.

The portion of alleyway adjacent to 117 Upper Meadow Street and 126 Hillman Street, and adjacent to the Youth Centre.

The entire length of Upper Meadow Street from houses numbered 126/178 and 117/155 on the other side, to include the footpath and roadway. Also to include the footpath and roadway in front of the Youth Centre.

The alleyway to rear of houses between 124/174 Upper Meadow Street and 121/169 Spamount Street.

Portion of alleyway adjacent to 169 and 171 Spamount Street.

The entire length of Spamount Street (adjacent to Lepper Street), to include both the footpaths and roadway, from houses numbered 7/121 and from 5/114 on the other side.
