Their sacrifice and dedication has saved many lives and helped preserve our city from those who would physically destroy it. The Council agrees to commission a stained glass window to acknowledge their dedication and service and install this in an appropriate location in the City Hall."</i></p> <p data-bbox="272 927 1474 1115">The Committee will recall that, at its meeting on 21<sup>st</sup> April, it considered a report (copy attached at appendix 1) on a proposal for a stained glass window to recognise the contribution of the LGBT community.
