3.1	<u>Key Issues</u> The power for the Council to name streets is contained in Article 11 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) (NI) Order 1995.

3.2 Members are asked to consider the following applications. The application particulars are in order and the Royal Mail has no objections to the proposed names. The proposed new name is not contained in the Council's Streets Register and does not duplicate existing approved street names in the City.

3.4 The housing association has proposed Oldpark Grange as the new street name as it is located off Oldpark Road and is in keeping with the existing names in the area. Bells Hill and Bells Lane have been proposed as a second and third choice as the development is being built on the site of a former blinds factory called the Charles Bell Blind Factory which previously provided employment to local residents.
