3.2	"This Council expresses its concern at the 16% increase in on-street car parking charges in Belfast, from £1.20 per hour to £1.40 per hour, announced by the Infrastructure Minister.  This decision will adversely affect City Centre retail trade and will advantage the out-of-town shopping centres which are able to offer free car parking.
3.3	The Council agrees to seek an urgent meeting with the Minister to ensure that there is improved consultation with all stakeholders, including the Council, regarding the transportation issues within the City, including for those who use cars and public transport and those who cycle and walk."
3.4	A letter was sent to the former Minister for Infrastructure, Chris Hazzard MLA, a copy of which is now attached.
3.5	In his response, the former Minister outlines that he had limited time to attend meetings in advance of the election and therefore had to decline the Council's invitation. However, he points out that his officials are available to attend any meetings being proposed.
