The visit will focus on innovative planning practice in Curitiba, which was one of the first cities in the world to implement a Bus Rapid Transit system, and will explore planning approaches overall as well as solutions relevant to age friendly environments. This may offer learning and insights that can support the Local Development Plan, which will have a crucial influence on restructuring the physical fabric of the city. The LDP will also have a critical role in helping achieve some of the core outcomes of the HU LAP project.
