3.2	In accordance with Standing Order 13(f), the motion was referred to the Committee			
0.2	for consideration.			
3.3	The Committee will recall that, at its meeting on 19th January, it had considered a			
	report on the audio recording of Area Based Working Group meetings (copy attached)			
	and had agreed to extend its policy and protocol on the recording of Standing			
	Committees to include those Groups.			
3.4	Should the Committee be minded to agree to extend the policy further, then the same			
	technical issues and protocols for the recording of Standing Committees and Area			
	Based Working Groups would apply. These will include appropriate consideration of			
	the content of reports and whether restrictions need to be applied.			
3.5	However, it should be pointed out that both the Audit and Risk Panel and the Shared
