3.1	<u>Key Issues</u> Members will recall that the initial Pride of Place Report was tabled for consideration at May's meeting. The report was withdrawn from the agenda as further information was required relating to cost and budgetary consideration.

3.2	This additional information was received from Co-operation Ireland after P&C Committee's meeting in June.
3.3	Given the timeframe for our nominations to be considered for the competition, selection and application process, it was critical that a decision was taken before the end of June. Therefore the Strategic Policy and Resources Committee was asked to consider and approve the Council's participation, with any decision being reported subsequently to the next People and Communities Committee. The report presented to SP&R is contained in Appendix 1.
