## North Link, BT11

65 people (77%) are in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate 1 person (1%) is not in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate 19 people (22%) did not respond to the survey

## Tardree Park, BT11

3.7 16 people (80%) are in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate 4 people (20%) did not respond to the survey

3.13	Financial & Resource Implications  There is a cost of approximately £1200 to cover the cost of the manufacturing and erection of the dual language street signs. The cost for these street signs has been allowed for in the current budget.
3.12	The Council's policy on the erection of a second street nameplate requires that at least two thirds (66.6%) of the people surveyed must be in favour of the proposal to erect a second street sign in a language other than English.
3.11	Norglen Parade, BT11 257 people (73%) are in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate 1 person (less than 1%) is not in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate 3 people (less than 1%) have no preference either way 92 people (1%) did not respond to the survey
3.10	Monagh Grove, BT11  1 person (100%) is in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate
3.9	Avoca Close, BT11  16 people (84%) are in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate  3 people (16%) did not respond to the survey
3.8	Norglen Gardens, BT11 42 people (69%) are in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate 1 person (2%) is not in favour of the erection of a second street nameplate 18 people (29%) did not respond to the survey
