Single Tender Actions (STAs) 3.2 The following STAs are being submitted for approval: Supply and Delivery of Fruit and Vegetables to Belfast Zoo (T1498). Ongoing service delivery whilst a formal procurement exercise is completed. The service covers a range of fruit, vegetables and other food items that are required to provide the animals at Belfast Zoo with a varied diet. The current contract is due to expire on 31st August 2020. Supplies of Alcohol based Sanitiser, urgent procurement to manage the impact of Covid19 (retrospective reporting for emergency supply).
