A copy of the invitation is attached as appendix 1.</p> <p>Each council will have an opportunity to meet with a small number of Committee Members for 30 minutes. Attendees will be given 10 minutes to brief Committee Members and this will be followed by 20 minutes for questions and answers. The event will take place on Wednesday 4 November 2020, in Parliament Buildings, Stormont, from 2.00pm to 5.00pm</p> <p>The Committee has invited two attendees from each council; one senior official and one political representative. This will allow for appropriate social distancing.
