

ABANDONMENT – DUNBAR LINK AND GREAT PATRICK STREET, BELFAST

The Department for Infrastructure (DfI) gives notice of its intention to make an Order under Article 68 of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993, the effect of which would be to abandon 253.24 square metres of former footpath consisting of two areas at Dunbar Link and Great Patrick Street, Belfast.

The areas of road proposed to be abandoned are delineated on a map which, together with a copy of a draft order, may be inspected free of charge during office hours within the period from 3rd March 2021 to 12th April 2021 at DfI Roads and Rivers Eastern Division, Annexe 7 Block 2, Castle Buildings, Stormont Estate, Upper Newtownards Road, Belfast.
