**KNOCKBRED A ROAD - REQUEST FOR A PEDESTRIAN CROSSING ADJACENT TO THE PROPOSED ENTRANCE TO CHERRYVALE PLAYING FIELDS.**

Thank you for your letter of 7 April 2021 requesting the provision of a pedestrian crossing adjacent to the proposed entrance to Cherryvale Playing Fields.

You may be aware that Councillor Gary McKeown wrote to me in February 2021, requesting the provision of pedestrian crossings on Knockbreda Road and on Ravenhill Road, at either side of the playing fields. In response to his request, and a separate request from Claire Hanna MP, I have asked my officials to explore the possibility of any provision as part of my Blue Green Initiative.

In my reply to Councillor McKeown, I suggested that Council officers working on this proposal should liaise closely with my officials as the proposals develop.
